


Smiths Court Hotel wedding ceremony



We are pleased to offer you a venue to hold your civil wedding ceremony. Our beautiful restaurant, The Orangery, combines elegance with contemporary style. The marble flooring and soaring sea views combine to provide a perfect venue for the start of your perfect day.

The Orangery is fully licensed to house civil wedding ceremonies. Eighty guests can be seated comfortably, so this is the suggested limit, although you can have some guests standing if you wish.

Brides enter from a private patio entrance at the back of The Orangery and walk down the marble aisle through their waiting guests, coming to rest in front of the Registrar in our bay window with a beautiful sea view.

After the ceremony, the balcony in front of The Orangery is a perfect setting for photographs, as are the front steps of the hotel, or there are the wide expanses of the Oval lawns and the bandstand opposite.

We provide a pedestal of flowers which will sit behind the ceremony table, and a sash in your colour scheme to go on your chairs and then be used for the rest of your day.

We also have a CD player which can play your choice of music throughout, as long as you provide the CDs. We can also arrange live music, and have a list of recommended pianists, harpists, saxophonists and guitarists who can accompany your walk down the aisle and during the signing of the register.

Room hire for the ceremony is £400, although this price halves to £200 when booked with any of our wedding packages. If you are having our Excellence Plus package, this room hire is included in your package.

It is important to note that The Orangery is only available for civil wedding ceremonies when booked with one of our wedding packages. We book the Registrar for the day, and then pass on all your details, **but payment for the Registrar is made directly with KCC.**
